

### Dear People of Saint Joseph Parish,

The Christmas Bazaar will be at the Parish Center this Saturday, December 2. Come to the Bazaar to make purchases, take a chance on the raffles, and enjoy the good company of all the people who are working at the Bazaar. Thank you to all the people who donated to the Bazaar. Your donations will turn into cash that the parish needs to continue the work of the local Church. Thank you to the people who are hard at work preparing to stage the event. They moved merchandise, planned the layout, set



up tables and chairs, and will sell goods and tickets on Saturday.

Remember the Pastor's Prize. I purchased scratch tickets and we will have two lucky winners. The first prize is Mass lottery scratch tickets, purchase price \$100. The second prize is Mass lottery scratch tickets, purchase price \$50.

The annual January Calendar Raffle will begin on January 1. You may have received your tickets in the mail or will receive them soon. Each day of January I will have someone pick a lucky winner at mass. Each weekday will award a \$25 prize and each Sunday will have a \$100 winner. The exception will be Sunday, January 28 when we will pick three winners. One winner will win \$200, another \$300 and still another will win \$500 on that day. Each winner in the raffle will also win a \$5 Massachusetts State Lottery Scratch Ticket.

Most parishioners will receive seven tickets in the mail with a letter that outlines this raffle. I received mine this week. Each calendar goes for \$10. The best deal is seven tickets for \$50. I will be busy processing the tickets and money and will be prepared to have the first winning ticket drawn on January 1, 2024.

People who want to participate in this raffle and have not received tickets in the mail can soon pick up the Calendar Raffle tickets on the last pews in the church or at the rectory. Make your returns through the mail, place them in the collection basket on the weekend or drop them at the rectory. Please mark your envelope with the words, "Calendar Raffle."

Support from this raffle will see the parish through the winter months when we pay heating and snow plowing bills. It will also allow the parish to pay down some of the debt that we owe from not paying bills to the diocese years ago. So far, we can still receive a dollar for dollar write off for every dollar we pay. Thank you for your participation.

St. Joseph Parish has a permit from the Town of Auburn to conduct this raffle and all the other raffles we conduct through the year. We must make an annual report to the town and pay a tax to the Massachusetts State Lottery Commission after each event.




### Preventing Child Abuse is Everyone's Responsibility
