



Dear People of Saint Joseph Parish,

Happy Saint Joseph Day! The Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saint Joseph on Tuesday, March 19.

Saint Joseph is the patron of the Universal Church. As he guided and protected Jesus in his care, so we look to him to guide and protect the Body of Christ, the Church. We can imitate his holiness. He had great faith to take Mary into his home as his wife after she was found to be pregnant with Jesus. He trusted God to guide him as he fled to Egypt after the visit of the Magi in the Gospel according to Matthew. He trusted God again when he returned to the homeland after the death of Herod.

Joseph was the husband of Mary. His devotion to her and Jesus is sincerely displayed in the search and discovery of Jesus in the Temple when Jesus was twelve years old. We can follow his example as we venerate Mary and adore Jesus.

We have authentic testimony about Joseph in the Gospels. Other literature about Joseph tends to distort the image that the Gospels portray.

He is the patron of our parish. He is a popular patron for parishes in the Diocese of Worcester. When we speak about our parish, we must always mention that it is in Auburn to distinguish it from all the other Saint Joseph parishes nearby. That a number of parishes in Worcester County should call

upon Saint Joseph to be the patron is appropriate since most of them were established with immigrants who

worked hard in factories and were dedicated to the raising of children.


Happy Saint Joseph Day on Tuesday.


