# Dear People of Saint Joseph Parish,

One of the blessings that we receive in the northern hemisphere during the Easter Season is the blossoming of the spring flowers. Thank you to all the parishioners who donated to the Easter Flower collection. The flowers that decorate the altar add to our celebration and remind us of the glory of the Resurrection. Parishioners donated to the collection in memory of deceased relatives and friends. May those who are remembered rejoice in the Resurrection and enjoy everlasting life.

The money collected at the Easter and Christmas flower collections does come very close to the amount we spend on the flowers for the holidays.



One of the most recognized flowers at the altar is the Easter lily. The large white trumpets seem to broadcast the glory of the resurrected Lord. The pristine white color reminds us of the purity of the mystery we celebrate in the Easter Season. We will see a repeat of this display at the end of June and the beginning of July when the lilies that were planted on the church property when they expired on Easters past will bloom again. The summertime display seems to extend the joy that we celebrate at Easter.

Then we will also get another reminder in the fall. The lilies that are in bloom at the altar today will expire and be planted outside. They were pushed to bloom for Easter. The same plant often sends up another stalk after they are planted outside and gives us at least one blossom just before the first frost of autumn.

Daffodils came to bloom in the church yard just as we approached Easter. Some were in full bloom, outside, behind the altar in the church. Others showed a little later in the bed to the west of the church. Still others showed up in front of the church near the front doors. They gave us some rich yellow color this spring.



The azalea are forming their blooms. We will not see them for at least a couple of weeks. The hydrangea wintered very well this year. The buds at the tips of the bushes have begun to break. I hope to see many big robust blue flowers from them this year.

Unfortunately, the tulip bulbs are a favorite snack of the local squirrels and other rodents. We have not seen many of them this year.

Thank you again to all the donors who supported the Easter Flower collection. Please enjoy the display inside the church and continue to see the beauty of God's creation through the rest of spring and into the summer.




# **WE NEED YOUR TREASURES AND YOUR HELP**
