





Food collections will be donated to Auburn Youth and Family Services.





Please, update the religious education forms and return with payment to the Religious Education office on or before July 31. After July 31st, a late fee of \$10.00 per student will be added. The registration fee remains the same at \$80.00 per student with cap of \$175.00 per family of 3 or more children. You can mail your registration with payment, drop it in the basket at mass, or place it in the box outside the parish center. The box is emptied daily. Welcome letters and a September calendar will be mailed by the middle of August.
